

Barrett Hollingsworth Texas Environmental Superconference Speaker Bio

Barrett is a staff attorney in the Litigation Division at the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) and provides legal support to the Supplemental Environmental Projects (SEP) program. She negotiates and drafts SEP agreements with third-party administrators of environmental enhancement projects, drafts guidance and documents for the program, and provides legal advice and training concerning the SEP program agency-wide. Barrett is also assigned to enforcement cases concerning a number of environmental topics. Additionally, she administers the Office of Legal Services' legal intern program.

Prior to joining TCEQ, Barrett served as Legislative Assistant and Legislative Director to members of the Texas House of Representatives during the 85th and 86th legislative sessions, and advised on a number of subject areas, such as environmental topics and education. During law school, Barrett worked at the Travis County Attorney's office and the Office of the Attorney General of Texas. Barrett earned her J.D. from the University of Texas School of Law in 2020, and her B.F.A. from Washington University in St. Louis in 2016.
